

## Pre-Placement Requirements:

Students who are client-facing are required to complete the following:

It is expected that educational programs maintain their own eligibility requirements for student placements and where eligibility requirements do not meet VON standards, additional requirements must be obtained before placement.

Similar to employees, we expect that students who interact with clients during a clinical placement can demonstrate they meet the health and safety requirements stated in our affiliation agreements. It is important to balance client, staff, and student safety with setting requirements that don't create undue barriers that may limit access to learning experiences.

In order for a student to be accepted for a clinical placement at VON, the following requirements must be met:

## **Required documents:**

Prior to the start of your placement, you will be required to complete and sign a Confidentiality Form and an Emergency Contact form. You will receive these forms either from your placement office or your preceptor prior to the first day of placement. Please complete the forms and bring them to your first placement day.



## Orientation:

You will complete a mandatory onsite orientation prior to your first day of placement. Orientation details will be communicated to you prior to the start of your placement.
