Community Aging in Place, Advancing Better Living for Elders

CAPABLE is an evidence-based program brought to you by VON in partnership with the Department of Seniors and Long-term Care and on behalf of the Johns Hopkins University School of Nursing.

What is the CAPABLE program?

CAPABLE teams work with clients over a period of 4 to 5 months to improve in-home safety and function so clients can remain independent in their own home longer.

Clients receive visits from:

- An Occupational Therapist
- A Nurse
- A Handy Worker who can make repairs or modifications within a modest budget



Handy Worker

The team works with the client to identify and address areas in their home and in their day-to-day life that can be improved so they can remain in their own home safely. Follow-up visits from the CAPABLE team will build on previous visits, increasing clients' independence and quality of life.

Who is eligible?

Adults 65 years+

And:

Have physical or mobility challenges due to health or home environment

And meet one of the following:

- Net income of \$85,000 or less; or
- Receive income assistance; or
- Receive the province's heating assistance rebate: or
- Receive the Guaranteed Income Supplement from Service Canada.

The CAPABLE program pilot is available in many neighbourhoods of the Halifax Regional Municipality and Kings County. Please visit von.ca/capable for eligible postal codes.
