Roger was diagnosed with dementia 10 years ago, and over time lost the support of friends and even some family members who found it difficult to cope with his memory loss. "He became more and more withdrawn," says his wife, Marion. "His world was suddenly reduced to the four walls of our home."

That is, until he started attending VON's Adult Day Program (ADP).

"We're at a point where Roger can't remember many things, but he always knows when it's getting close to Tuesday," Marion says with a smile.

ADP gives people living with dementia purpose and helps overcome isolation. And for family members like Marion, not only does it give them comfort knowing their loved ones are safe and able to take part in activities that bring meaning and joy back into their lives, but it also gives them a break from the demands of caregiving.



We're testing the neighbourhood hub model, designed to make care accessible and close to home, and expanding nursing capacity and scope with community clinics for home-care patients who are mobile.

We're enhancing Adult Day Programs to include clients who need additional supports and physical assistance, and increasing access to primary care in North Bay with the new nurse practitioner clinic.

We're supporting patients posthospital stay with up to six weeks of care, and employing a team of nurses specializing in wound, ostomy, and continence in Ontario to ensure clients have quick access to high-quality care.
