About VON Clinics

VON continues to work with Nova Scotia Health Continuing Care to improve access to community nursing care. VON clients may receive care in their homes, at a local VON clinic, through virtual appointments or by a combination of these three methods.

In VON clinics, registered nurses (RNs) and licensed practical nurses (LPNs) collaborate to provide comprehensive nursing care. VON clinics are a convenient way to access services such as wound care, medication administration, pain and symptom management and intravenous therapy, in a timely and efficient manner.

Clients who are able to get to a VON clinic, and are referred to community nursing through Nova Scotia Health Continuing Care, will be contacted by VON to schedule nursing care at one of our clinics. VON nurses will continue to assess the best service location based on your individual clinical needs while receiving VON services.
