eHomecare is an innovative model of care that has directing registered nurses (DRNs) remotely and simultaneously direct the care of multiple patients.

eHomecare Overview

With VON's eHomecare, a directing registered nurse (DRN) uses a secure technology platform to direct the specific care needs of patients and delegate tasks to multiple specially trained (enhanced) personal support workers (PSWs), called healthcare technicians (HCTs). With this unique approach, DRNs are able to simultaneously manage the care of multiple patients.

HCTs deliver care to clients at their places of care, acting as the eyes, ears and hands of the DRN. HCTs send data and observations to the DRN, who assesses the information and provides direction for appropriate care and support in real time.

Who does eHomecare serve?

eHomecare is an innovative and efficient model of care that supports the needs of clients of all ages. It is used within several VON programs, including palliative care, Hospice at Home, pediatric care, eHomecare school program, CC2H (for patients with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and congestive heart failure) and virtual clinics.

Benefits of eHomecare

eHomecare provides care and comfort efficiently and effectively. With eHomecare:

- One nurse remotely simultaneously manages the care of multiple patients, supervising several HCTs. This allows VON to care for more clients every day.
- With HCTs at the place of care, the reach of our skilled nurses is expanded so that clients can receive more complex in-home care without waiting for a visiting nurse.
- HCTs are specially trained to provide enhanced skills and delegated tasks, including administering narcotics, monitoring vital signs, oral suctioning and tube feeding.
- Clients receive care in the safety and comfort of their usual place of care, reducing their stress and the burden on caregivers.
- eHomecare is a 24-hour service with a dedicated direct patient line for issues and questions. A patient can be assessed by the DRN, resulting in reduced ER visits and prevention of hospital admission.
- Increased access to specialized home care may promote earlier discharge from hospital.

Who refers clients to eHomecare?

eHomecare is fully funded by Home and Community Care Support Services (HCCSS). Patients must meet specific eligibility criteria for admission to the program.



What do clients think of eHomecare?

A grateful friend of an eHomecare client with cancer told us how the care provided by the VON HCT has impacted the client and her loved ones:

66 She is amazing - she is always on time, here until the last minute and stays if we need her. She is attentive, caring, loving and she helps us with understanding things that my friend is going through. 99
